Handling and Application

- This product is suitable for cold lamination using a laminator.
- Ensure that the material has reached room temperature and a relative humidity of 50% before printing.
- Do not handle the face film, ensure free from dust and static.
- Allow the inks to cure before overlaminating, this is usually 24-48 hours (darker colours can be longer).
- Suitable for use on Eco Solvent, Solvent, Latex & UV prints.
- The product is matched to MD5. Matched laminates prevent tunnelling and delamination.
- Apply around 30°C on the top roller to prevent silvering of the adhesive.
- The user should determine suitability of the overlaminate to the print media.
