

Colours have weak vibrancy on Backlit or Window Graphics

Problem	Solution	Explanation
Colours appear weak when printing on Backlit or Translucent Vinyl for Lightboxes	We recommend using the function in the RIP colour management called 'overprint' to print 2x to achieve colour vibrancy when printing on Backlit or Translucent.	Greater ink opacity can be needed for internally illuminated graphics.
Colours appear weak when printing on Transparent for Window Graphics	If you wish to achieve transparent graphics, follow above suggestions. If you wish to achieve fully opaque graphics, print in reverse onto transparent vinyl (eg: MD5-105), then laminate a White Vinyl (eg: MD5-100) on the reverse, and apply this to the window.	Backing up the transparent vinyl with white vinyl restores the full colours.
