The film and adhesive both contain UV stabilisers to prolong the life of the print, and a high level of resistance to weathering. It is supplied with a solvent-based adhesive for trouble free application, with a clear polyester liner. The 20 micron polyester film provides a thin lamination over the print and can be applied onto flat or 2D curved surfaces.

- Ensure that the material has reached room temperature and a relative humidity of 50% before printing.
- Do not handle the face film, ensure free from dust and static.

- Suitable for use on Solvent, Eco Solvent, Latex and UV prints on Metamark print media.
- This product is not suitable for 3D compound curves and is not conformable.
- Allow the inks to cure before overlaminating, usually 24-48 hours (not applicable to latex prints). Failure to do so can cause delamination, tunnelling and shrinkage.
- The user should determine suitability of the overlaminate to the print media.
